

THE SERBIA-BORN COMMUNITY IN VICTORIA: 2011 CENSUS



At the 2011 Census, there were 7,382 Serbia-born persons in Victoria (36.4% of Australia's total), increasing by 10.8% (722) from 6,660 persons in 2006. The Serbia-born were distributed throughout Metropolitan Melbourne, with slight concentrations in the local government areas of Casey (11.1%); Brimbank (10.9%); Greater Dandenong (10.4%); Wyndham (5.6%); and Greater Geelong (4.9%). Almost two-thirds (63.2%) of the Serbia-born in Victoria had arrived in Australia prior to 1991; 21.9% had arrived between 1991 and 2000; and 11.7% had arrived between 2001 and 2011.

The Serbia-born community reflected an aging profile: 10.0% were aged 25 years and below; 22.9% were aged 26-44 years; 42.6% were aged 45-64 years; and 24.5% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 52 years, compared to 37 years for the total Victorian population. The gender ratio was 94 males to 100 females, compared to 98 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

Two-fifths (42.9%) of the Serbia-born were Serbian Orthodox; 16.7% were Eastern Orthodox not further defined; 10.3% were Western Catholic; 9.7% were Greek Orthodox; 7.0% had no religion. Most (88.4%) spoke a language other than English; 16.2% assessed themselves as speaking English not well or not at all. Most (91.5%) held Australian Citizenship, compared to 63.1% for the total overseas-born population in Victoria. Two-fifths (40.6%) of the Serbia-born aged 15 years and over received a weekly personal income of less than \$400; 7.8% received no income.




