
## **FACT SHEET NUMBER A-92**





The Libya-born community reflected a young to ageing profile: 14.0% were aged 25 years and below; 24.7% were aged 26-44 years; 34.7% were aged 45-64 years; and 26.9% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 54 years, compared to 37 years for the total Victorian population. The gender ratio was 115 males to 100 females, compared to 98 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

Over half (57.4%) were Western Catholic; 31.2% followed Islam; 3.1% had no religion. Four-fifths (78.9%) spoke a language other than English; 18.5% assessed themselves as speaking English not well or not at all. Two-thirds (65.1%) held Australian Citizenship, compared to 63.1% for the total overseas-born population in Victoria. Over one-third (37.1%) of the Libya-born aged 15 years and over received a weekly personal income of less than \$400; 14.0% received no income.




