

**Demographic characteristics**

At the 2016 Census, there were 1,423 UK etc. nfd-born persons in Victoria (20.3% of Australia's total), ranked 89<sup>th</sup> among the overseas-born communities in Victoria. The UK etc. nfd-born increased by 217.6% (975) from 448 persons in 2011. They are distributed throughout Metropolitan Melbourne, with concentrations in the LGAs of Mornington Peninsula (4.9%), Bayside (4.4%), Port Phillip (4.4%) and Melbourne (3.8%); 13.3% live in regional Victoria and 4.3% live in the regional LGA of Greater Geelong.

The UK etc. nfd-born reflected a balanced to mature age profile: 18.7% were aged 25 years and under; 30.7% were aged 26-44; 29.4% were aged 45-64; and 21.2% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 45 years, compared to 37 years for total Victoria. The gender ratio was 119 males to 100 females, compared to 96 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

There were 263 persons identified with Channel Islander ancestry. Most of them were born in Australia (59.7%), Guernsey (12.2%), Jersey (11.0%) and England (9.1%). Almost half (45.1%) of UK etc. nfd-born in Victoria had arrived in Australia before 1996; 5.0% arrived in 1996-2000; 8.3% arrived in 2001-2005; 15.5% arrived in 2006-2010; and 21.0% arrived in 2011-2016.

Most (87.4%) of the UK etc. nfd-born speak English only. They follow a variety of religions: 14.8% are Anglican; 13.7% are Catholic; 5.0% are Presbyterian/Reform; 3.9% are Christian not further defined; 2.7% are Uniting Church; 39.4% have no religion. Over half (53.8%) of the UK etc. nfd-born have Australian citizenship, compared to 58.3% for the overseas-born in Victoria.

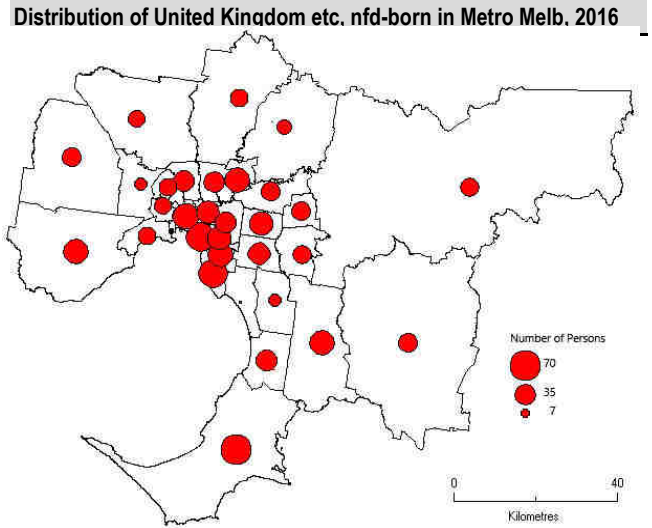

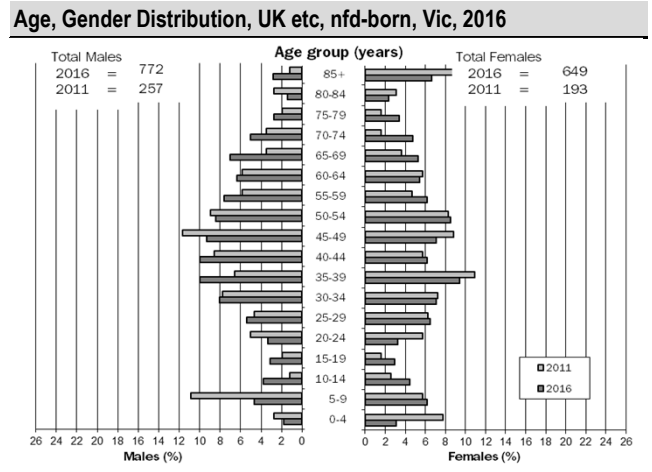

## Economic characteristics

The education levels of the UK etc. nfd-born are higher than for total Victoria; 10.8% have a postgraduate degree; 23.7% have a bachelor degree; and 11.2% have an advanced diploma or diploma, compared to 5.4%, 16.5% and 9.2% for Victoria.

The labour force participation rate of the UK etc. nfd-born at 64.1% is higher than that of total Victoria at 60.5%. Their unemployment rate at 5.0% is lower than total Victoria at 6.6%.

The occupational patterns of the UK etc. nfd-born are different from those for total Victoria. More of them work as managers (15.9%) and professionals (36.5%), compared to Victoria (13.5% and 23.3%). Less of them work as community & personal service workers (7.3%), machinery operators & drivers (2.6%) and labourers (4.5%), compared to Victoria (10.6%, 5.8% and 9.0%).

The industry of employment patterns of the UK etc. nfd-born are also different from total Victoria. Less of them are employed in wholesale & retail trade (8.4%) and accommodation & food services (4.6%), compared to Victoria (13.4% and 6.6%). More of them are employed in professional, scientific, technical & administration (18.4%), education & training (11.0%) and health care & social assistance (15.5%), compared to Victoria (11.4%, 8.6% and 12.5%).

The weekly personal income distribution pattern for the UK etc. nfd-born is higher than total Victoria. Less of them receive nil income (7.2%), \$1-\$399 (14.2%) and \$400-\$799 (20.8%), compared to 9.7%, 20.1% and 23.1% for Victoria. More of them receive \$1,250-\$1,999 (17.8%) and \$2,000 or more (15.5%), compared to 13.6% and 7.5% for Victoria.
